■ A few days after Mongolia's first free election in 1990, the New Testament was published in the Mongolian language. It received acclaim from secular Mongolian scholars.

■ Bible Society's fully qualified translators have continued to work on the translation of the whole Bible. Many missionaries and others assisted with back-translation of the Bible from Mongolian into English so that Translation Consultants from the Bible Society of New Zealand, the Bible Society of Australia, and Wycliffe Bible Translators could check the completed work.



- Since it was founded in 1990 the Bible Society of Mongolia has also translated the Children's Bible, Christian books, videos, movies, Braille Scriptures, individual books of the Old Testament and children's Bible narrative books. Thousands of items of scripture have been distributed.
- There is extreme poverty in Mongolia, so the Bible Society of Mongolia is able to heavily subsidise the cost of Christian literature, thanks to supporters like you.



- We are grateful to God for raising up people all over the world who pray and give to the work of the Bible Society of Mongolia so that all people have the opportunity to read about the saving work of the Lord Jesus Christ.

2. Invest in Bible publishing


